#### **ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT**

Anna's House is offering an eleven week summer camp program for students between three and eleven years of age. Summer camp will be split into groups, which will be dependent on the number of campers signed up for each week. The programs will be designed around a weekly theme that provides focus and direction. Each themed session will included a balanced variety of indoor and outdoor games, arts and crafts, and walking each week! Campers will also have weekly walking field trips around the City of Staunton. Please be aware this program is organized as an active camp experience, taught and guided by trained Anna's House staff. Children will spend a good portion of time outside and will get wet and dirty every day. Appropriate clothing and footwear are essential. PLEASE LABEL ALL YOUR CHILDREN'S THINGS

Parent(s) agree not to hold Anna's House, or any of their employees responsible in case of an accident or incident involving their child. Anna's House does not discriminate in its enrollment or hiring practices in regard to race, religion, gender, or nationality. The school is non-denominational and its policy encourages diversity and internationalism as well as social and ecological awareness and stewardship.
